About this volunteer role

Our team provides farming experience and friendship for Autistic adults, adults with Learning Disabilities and Learning Difficulties and teaches children and young people how to look after the environment. As you can imagine, this is at the centre of the work we do and the services we provide. All activities are inspired by and, indeed, take place in and around our working farmyard, gardens, on site café (run by Smile for Life Children's Charity) and popular visitor centre, which attracts 40,000 people every year.

As an Events & Marketing Volunteer, you will run, support, and capture a variety of sustainability focused events around the farm – whether this be a current event we hold such as pond dipping or a new event such as butterfly counting or bee walks. You could be involved in the planning, promotion and delivery as well as gathering feedback from attendees. The seasonal nature of this role will determine the type of events and when. This is all carried out under the guidance of our Farm Manager and Communication and Fundraising Lead.

Role responsibilities

Roles and responsibilities may look different depending on your skills and interests and will be agreed during your application and induction. Roles and responsibilities could include:

 Supporting the planning of events with a sustainable and environmental focus

• Creating promotional material for events

• Assisting with event marketing campaigns


Running or supporting a staff member in the running of an event

Stewarding at larger events




Gathering feedback during and following an event

All volunteers must provide two character references and complete a DBS check.

- Attend scheduled volunteer meetings
